The Animal Protection League of New Jersey herewith offers to buy out the Borough's contract with USDA Wildlife Services, most especially that part which pertains to gassing Canada geese during the molt. It is our understanding that Edgewater's portion of the contract is \$5999.00.

Further, the League is prepared to coordinate and carry out needed landscaping changes with the result of deterring geese. This includes contacting and engaging appropriate landscaping assistance and the purchase of required grasses, shrubs, fencing and other barriers. In addition, the League will be glad to assist in effective signage and other measures to discourage the feeding of geese.

The above actions will result in dissuading Canada geese from targeted areas without resorting to gassing the birds.
