## **Town Benefits of Trap-Neuter-Return**

TNR is a comprehensive program that will:

- **Save your municipality money and staff time**
  - Municipalities unnecessarily spend thousands to board and kill stray and feral kittens/cats
  - ACO spends a lot of time trapping or responding to residents complaints
  
- **Protects the public health**
  - Vaccinate cats who are currently not rabies vaccinated
  
- **Reduce the # of animals killed in the municipal shelter each year**
  - Cats and kittens make up the majority of animals entering the shelter as well as those who are killed
  
- **Improve community relations**
  - Residents and employees care about cats and are upset the town kills them.
  - Reduction of complaints regarding nuisance behavior generally attributed to unaltered cats
  - TNR fosters a cooperative relationship between residents and animal control and health departments
